- Antigua Naval Dockyard and Related Archaeological Sites in **Antigua and Barbuda** were inscribed on UNESCO's prestigious World Heritage List.
- Scientists in **Argentina** have discovered a previously unknown carnivorous dinosaur, named Gualicho shinyae, that has small arms similar to those of the Tyrannosaurus Rex.
- Surgeons have performed **Australian**-first surgery on a baby diagnosed with spina bifida while it was still in the womb at Mater Mothers' Hospital.
- João and Leticia of **Brazil** received the prestigious Google Community Impact Award for Latin America for introducing a water filtering system for Brazilians to easily treat their water.
- **English, Dutch** and **American** researchers have presented a new map of the human brain characterizing 97 previously undiscovered areas.
- **English** F1 driver Lewis Hamilton recorded his fifth Hungarian Grands Prix win in Budapest.
- **German** researchers have discovered that bacteria from the human nose produce a novel antibiotic, named lugdunin, which is effective against multiresistant pathogens.
- **Iranian** film director Asghar Farhadi's drama The Salesman won the ARRI/Osram Award for Best International Film at the 2016 Munich Film Festival.
- Researchers from the Okinawa Institute of Science & Technology Graduate University, **Japan** have discovered two new ant species and named them Pheidole drogon and Pheidole viserion.
- Vientiane Rescue, a free ambulance service on a 24/7 basis, in **Laos** won the prestigious 2016 Ramon Magsaysay Award.
- **Latvia** was named Europe's fastest growing innovator, according to the European Commission ranking.
- **New Zealander** Lydia Ko won the Best Female Golfer award at the 2016 ESPY Awards held in Los Angeles.
- **Nigerian** journalist Didi Akinyelure won the second BBC World News Komla Dumor Award.
- Team ENTy of **Romania** took the top spot at the 2016 Microsoft Imagine Cup World Champion in Innovation category for their app for monitoring balance and posture.
- **Scotland**'s Andy Murray became Wimbledon tennis champion for the second time with a superb win 6-4 7-6 (7-3) 7-6 (7-2) against Canadian Milos Raonic.
- **Sweden** was named Europe's most innovative country, according to the European Commission ranking.
- **Swiss** Solar Impulse 2 completed its historic round-the-world journey, becoming the first airplane to circle the globe powered only by the sun.
- **Tanzania** banned the smoking of shishas or water pipes over health concerns.
