D+ News: July 2023

- The 13th edition of the Pan Arab Games, an international multi-sport event was proudly hosted by **Algeria**.
- **Belgian** cyclist Jasper Philipsen of the Alpecin-Deceuninck team won the third stage of the Tour de France.
- Star **Chinese** swimmer Qin Haiyang shattered the world record in the men's 200 metres breaststroke event at the World Aquatics Championships in a time of two minutes, 05.48 seconds.
- Marketa Vondrousova of **Czech Republic** won the 2023 Wimbledon ladies' singles final, defeating Ons Jabeur 6-4 6-4 to become lowest ranked winner in history.
- **Danish** rider Jonas Vingegaard won the Tour de France for a second straight year as cycling's most famous race finished on the famed Champs-Élysées.
- Scientists in **Germany** have revived a worm that was frozen 46,000 years ago — at a time when woolly mammoths, sabre-toothed tigers and giant elks still roamed the Earth.
- The **Indian** Space Research Organisation (ISRO) successfully launched the Chandrayaan-3 mission, its third Moon mission, aiming to be the first to land near its little-explored south pole.
- The Dutch government announced to return hundreds of stolen art and cultural artifacts to **Indonesia** and **Sri Lanka**, former Dutch colonies.
- Researchers from the Osaka University **Japan** have developed a fluorescent sensor that allows them to see connections between brain cells being made and removed via a specific adhesion molecule.
- **Kuwait's** Sheikh Talal Fahad Al Ahmad Al Sabah was elected as the new President of the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) at the OCA General Assembly in Bangkok.
- Weightlifter Ahsaan Shabi provided **Libya's** first gold medals of the 2023 Pan Arab Games in Algeria in the men's 73 kilograms snatch and clean and jerk competition.
- **Nigerian** President Bola Tinubu was elected as the Chairman of the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS) Authority of Heads of State and Government at the Sixty-Third Ordinary Session of the Authority held in Bissau, Guinea-Bissau.
- Hamza Khan of **Pakistan** won the World Junior Squash title defeating Egypt's Mohamed Zakaria 3-1 in a thrilling match in Melbourne, Australia. Pakistan won the title after 37 years since Jansher Khan's win in 1986.
- Veteran **Palestinian** news reporter Shireen Abu Akleh was posthumously named as one of the winners at the 2023 Courage in Journalism Award by the International Women's Media Foundation.
- Team **Qatar** won the gold medal in the Handball final at the Pan Arab Games 2023 beating Saudi Arabia 37-24 in the final.
- **Russian** Andrey Rublev beat Norwegian top seed Casper Ruud 7-6(3) 6-0 in the final of the Swedish Open to claim his second claycourt title of the year in Bastad.
