D+ News: February 2019

- A herbivorous dinosaur that fended off predators with a row of spines running along its back and lived 140 million years ago has been discovered in **Argentine** Patagonia.
- **Australian** researchers have discovered immune cells that can fight all known flu viruses – creating the potential for the development of a world-first universal, one-shot flu vaccine.
- **Austrian** ski star Marcel Hirscher captured a sixth World Cup slalom crown in Stockholm.
- **Canadian** and **Spanish** scientists have discovered a cave-dwelling new species of insect, *Haplocampa wagnelli*, in British Columbia in Canada.
- **Croatia** became an associate member of world's largest scientific research center CERN.
- **Egyptian** government assumed the presidency of African Union (AU), a continental union consisting of 55 African countries.
- Researchers in Oxford, **England** have carried out the world's first gene therapy operation to tackle the root cause of age-related macular degeneration (AMD), the UK's most common cause of sight loss.
- **Equatorial Guinea** took over the rotating presidency of the UN Security Council for the month of February.
- The **Fijian** Government extended the 10-year ban on hunting and selling sea turtles which is to continue till the end of this year.
- A team of **German** researchers has discovered that cells use sugars to communicate at the molecular level.
- **Indian** researchers from the University of Delhi have discovered a new species of frog, named *Mysticellus*, in the Western Ghats in India.
- **Israeli** director Nadav Lapid won the Berlin International Film Festival's top Golden Bear award for his film *Synonyms*.
- **Japanese** spacecraft Hayabusa2 sent to collect samples from an asteroid 300 million kilometers away for clues about the origin of life and the solar system landed successfully.
- NATO states signed the Accession Protocol agreement for **Macedonia**, or the future Republic of North Macedonia, clearing the way for the Balkan nation to become the military alliance's 30th member.
- **Mexican** film *Roma* won the Best Foreign Language Film award at the 91st Academy Awards.
- **Qatar** clinched a historic first ever Asian Cup football title with a stunning 3-1 win over Japan in the UAE.
- **Serbian** tennis great Novak Djokovic was named Laureus World Sportsman of the.
- **Vietnamese** airlines were granted permission to fly to the United States for the first time after the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration announced that Vietnam complies with international safety standards.
