D+ News: August 2016

- In an extraordinary find, a team of **Australian** researchers have uncovered the world's oldest fossils in a remote area of Greenland. The 3.7 billion year old fossils will provide a greater understanding of early diversity of life on Earth.
- Shaunae Miller of **Bahamas** won the Women's 400m race gold at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in Brazil.
- The 2016 Summer Olympics was inaugurated in Rio de Janeiro, **Brazil**. Rio became the first South American city to host the Summer Olympics.
- **China** successfully launched the world's first quantum satellite, Quantum Experiments at Space Scale (QUESS), from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Center in north-western Gobi.
- **Denmark's** Pernille Blume won women's 50m freestyle swimming gold by just two-hundredths of a second at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in Brazil.
- **Ethiopia's** Almaz Ayana smashed the world record by over 14 seconds to win Olympic gold in the women's 10,000m race at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in Brazil.
- **Fiji** won their first ever Olympic medal beating Great Britain 43-7 in men's rugby sevens for gold at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in Brazil.
- Kimia Alizadeh became the first ever **Iranian** woman to win Olympic medal after claiming taekwondo bronze at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in Brazil.
- **Jamaica's** Usain Bolt became the first athlete to win three Olympic 100m race titles by winning gold at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in Brazil.
- **Mauritius** ranked first in Africa at the United Nations E-Government Survey 2016, indicating its ability to provide government services and information through the Internet.
- Jong Sim Rim of **North Korea** won gold in Women's 75kg Weightlifting at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games in Brazil.
- Joseph Isaac Schooling won **Singapore's** first-ever Olympic gold medal with 100m butterfly swimming victory at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games with an Olympic Record time 50.39s.
- The University of the Witwatersrand, **South Africa** ranked first in Africa at the 2016 Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU).
- **South Sudan** competed in the Olympic Games for the first time at the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.
- **Switzerland** topped the 2016 Global Innovation Index that ranks countries based on their capacities and results for innovation.
- The **United Arab Emirates** (UAE) opened the world's biggest family and leisure indoor park, IMG Worlds of Adventure, in Dubai.
- The **United States of America** created the largest marine reserve on the planet, by expanding the Papahānaumokuākea Marine National Monument off the coast of Hawaii to 582,578 square miles.
