## D+ News: March 2024

- **Bangladesh** clinched the title of SAFF Women's U-16 Football Championship defeating India 3-2 on penalties in the final at ANFA Complex in Nepal's Kathmandu.
- **China's** first self-developed civil airship, the AS700 "Xiangyun", completed its first trial flight between two airports in Central China's Hubei Province, and completed a 180-kilometer flight.
- **English** researchers have shown for the first time that a crucial interface in a protein, Epidermal Growth Factor Receptor (EGFR), that drives cancer growth could act as a target for more effective treatments.
- **Finland** was crowned as the world's happiest country for a seventh successive year according to the 2024 World Happiness Report compiled by Gallup, the United Nations, and the University of Oxford.
- The Dia Art Foundation in New York announced **Ghanaian** sculptor, textile and installation artist Ibrahim Mahama as the winner of the inaugural Sam Gilliam Award, which comes with \$75,000.
- **India** signed a \$100bn free trade agreement with a four-member European bloc European Free Trade Association (EFTA) States – Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, and Switzerland - will see investments across a range of Indian sectors, including pharmaceuticals, machinery and manufacturing.
- **Iranian** filmmaker Hamidreza Arjomandi won the Best Emerging Filmmaker award at the 2024 Through Women's Eyes International Film Festival in Florida, USA for her film The Borders Never Die.
- **Netherlands** runner Femke Bol broke her own 400 meters world record at the world athletics indoor championships. Bol won in 49.17 seconds and took 0.07 off the record she set two weeks ago at the Dutch championships.
- Scientists on an expedition to the Bounty Trough off **New Zealand** have discovered about 100 new or potentially new ocean species, as revealed by National Institute of Water and Atmospheric (NIWA).
- Researchers have discovered new species of Dwarf Deer, *Pudella carlae*, in **Peru** that belongs to the Neotropical deer tribe *Odocoileini*. Their discovery was presented in the Journal of Mammalogy.
- A **Russian** Soyuz spacecraft carrying a Russian, a Belarusian and an American en route to the International Space Station (ISS) was successfully launched from the Baikonur cosmodrome in Kazakhstan.
- The United Nations (UN) selected **Saudi Arabia** to chair its Commission on the Status of Women in New York.
- **Spanish** racing driver Carlos Sainz won the 2024 Australian Grand Prix, the third F1 race win of his career, representing Ferrari in Melbourne.
