D+ News: September 2023

- **Algerian** football club USM Alger won the African Super Cup with a 1-0 victory over favourites Al Ahly of Egypt.
- Scientists in **Australia** have unearthed the fossil of a new genus of trapdoor spider, named *Megamonodontium mccluskyi*, believed to be anywhere from 11 to 16 million years old.
- Astronomers from **Canada, Australia** and **China** have discovered a rare 'polar ring galaxy' wrapped in a huge ribbon of hydrogen.
- Scientists in **China** have found a new virus at the bottom of the Mariana Trench, at a depth of 29,199 feet (8,900 meters). The virus, called vB_HmeY_H4907, was detailed in the journal *Microbiology Spectrum*.
- **Ethiopian** runner Gudaf Tsegay electrified the crowd with her spectacular 5,000m win in 14min 00.21sec at the Diamond League finals.
- Tourism **Fiji** was named as the Oceania's Leading Tourist Board at the 2023 World Travel Awards held in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam.
- **India** launched its first spacecraft, called Aditya-L1, dedicated to studying the sun from Sriharikota.
- **Japan** successfully launched a homegrown H-IIA rocket carrying a lunar exploration spacecraft from Tanegashima Space Center in southern Japan.
- **North Korea** launched its first domestically built operational tactical nuclear attack submarine — named Hero Kim Kun Ok.
- **Pakistan** cricket captain Babar Azam was crowned ICC Men's Player of the Month and became the first men's player to win the award on three separate occasions.
- Tell es-Sultan, an oval-shaped tell, or mound, that contains the prehistorical deposits of human activity, in **Palestine** was added to UNESCO World Heritage.
- Two **Russian** cosmonauts and an **American** astronaut successfully lifted off from the Baikonur cosmodrome in Kazakhstan aboard the Russian Soyuz MS-24 spacecraft on a quick trip to the International Space Station.
- **Serbian** tennis star Novak Djokovic won his 24th Grand Slam singles title at 2023 US Open men's singles final with a 6-3, 7-6(5), 6-3 victory over Daniil Medvedev.
- **Spain's** Alex Palou clinched the 2023 IndyCar season drivers championship by winning the Portland Grand Prix.
- **Swedish** pole vault champion Armand Duplantis improved his own world record with a leap of 6.23m at the Diamond League finals.
- **Syria** and **China** announced the formation of a strategic partnership during Syrian President Bashar Assad's meeting with Chinese President Xi Jinping in China. This partnership will secure much needed financial support to rebuild Syria as the recently ended civil war in the country devastated the local economy.
