## D+ News: December 2022

- **Argentina** won the 2022 FIFA World Cup on penalties 4-2 over France after the game finished at 3-3 after extra time.
- Researchers from the Museum of Tropical Queensland have discovered **Australia's** first complete plesiosaur fossil near the remote western Queensland town of McKinlay.
- "Kura Pokkhir Shunye Ura" (The Golden Wings of Watercocks) of **Bangladesh** and "Upon Entry" of **Spain** jointly won the Best Film award in the international category at the 28th Kolkata International Film Festival.
- A team of researchers from **Canada, South Korea** and **Mongolia** has discovered a species of dinosaur, named Natovenator polydontus, that may have been able to swim.
- **China** successfully sent a new test satellite, VHF Data Exchange System (VDES) test satellite, into space from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Center in northwest China.
- The European Union (EU) voted for **Croatia** to join the Schengen Area at the start of 2023 which will allow its citizens freely move across most of the Europe.
- A team of **German** and international astronomers has discovered some of the most ancient stars in the Milky Way and tracked their positions and motions. This information has provided new insights into how our very own galaxy came to be 13 billion years ago.
- **India** officially assumed the G20 presidency for a year aimed at securing global economic growth and prosperity.
- **Israeli** scientists at the Israeli Agricultural Research Organization-Volcani Center have created a species of egg-laying hens that only produce females, a breakthrough that could help end the annual culling of around seven billion male chicks globally.
- A **Japanese** spacecraft, built by Tokyo-based startup Ispace, was launched to the moon in the country's first-ever lunar mission and the first of its kind by a private company.
- **New Zealand** parliament passed a bill banning anyone born after 2008 to be able to buy cigarettes or tobacco products.
- Iga Swiatek of **Poland** was honoured as WTA Player of the Year for the first time after rising to No. 1 in the rankings in April and remaining there for the rest of the season.
- **Saint Lucia** was named as the best travel destination in the Caribbean at the 20th annual Travel Weekly Readers' Choice Awards in New York.
- **Saudi Arabia** and **China** signed a strategic partnership agreement during a visit by the Chinese leader Xi Jinping to the kingdom, a series of strategic deals, including one involving Chinese tech giant Huawei.
- **Swedish** pole vaulter Mondo Duplantis won the World Athlete of the year award, claiming the award for the second time in three years with three world records in 2022 plus the men's world indoor title in March and the world outdoor gold in July.
