## D+ News: May 2023

- **Belgium's** Luca Brecel won the 2023 snooker World Championship beating Mark Selby 18-15 in the final.
- A team of international astronomers — including researchers from the University of British Columbia in **Canada** — has discovered 62 new moons of Saturn.
- **China** and **Russia** signed new economic pacts, included an agreement to deepen investment co-operation in trade services, a pact on export of agricultural products to China, and another on sports co-operation, during Russian Prime Minister Mikhail Mishustin's visit to Beijing.
- A team of astronomers led by the University of Southampton in **England** have uncovered the largest cosmic explosion, known as AT2021lwx, ever witnessed. The explosion is more than ten times brighter than any known supernova.
- An international research team led by the Max Planck Institute for Evolutionary Anthropology in Leipzig, **Germany**, has retrieved human DNA from a Paleolithic pendant and discovered that it belonged to a Siberian woman who lived roughly 25,000 years ago.
- **Iran** and **Russia** signed an agreement to build a railway line to create an international transport route linking South Asia to Northern Europe.
- **Israeli** archaeologists have discovered an ancient 2,000-year-old receipt carved into a chalkstone slab along the City of David's Pilgrimage Road in Jerusalem.
- **Italian** author and philosopher Nuccio Ordine won Spain's 2023 Princess of Asturias award for communication and humanities.
- Formula 1 driver Max Verstappen of the **Netherlands** produced a masterclass to outwit Red Bull team mate Sergio Perez and win the Formula One Miami Grand Prix.
- **Sri Lankan** baker Tharshan Selvarajah won the title for best baguette in Paris at the 30th Grand Prix de la Baguette de Tradition Francaise de la Ville De Paris contest.
- **Swedish** singer Loreen has won the 67th Eurovision Song Contest with her song Tattoo.
- The Arab League adopted a decision to readmit **Syria** after more than a decade of suspension, consolidating a regional push to normalise ties between the Arab nations.
- Researchers at the Washington State University in the **USA** have developed a robotic bee that can fly fully in all directions, the Bee++ prototype is the first to fly stably in all directions.
- **French** murder mystery film Anatomy of a Fall won the Palme d'Or, the top prize at the 2023 Cannes Film Festival.
- Veteran Sherpa guide Kami Rita from **Nepal** scaled Mount Everest for the record 28th time, beating his own previous record.
- Neeraj Chopra, the reigning men's Olympic javelin throw champion, from **India** won the javelin throw event at the 2023 Doha Diamond League with a world-leading effort of 88.67m in Qatar.
