## D+ News: June 2023

- Scientists in **Australia** have discovered ancient organisms, known as the ‘Protosterol Biota’, that lived in Earth’s waterways at least 1.6 billion years ago could change our understanding of our earliest ancestors.
- **Austria**’s capital Vienna retained the top position as the world’s most liveable city, according to the Economist Intelligence Unit’s (EIU) Global Liveability Index.
- **Bangladesh** women team won the football gold defeating Israel 2-0 in the 2023 Special Olympics World Games in Berlin.
- **Chinese** golfer Yin Ruoning produced a flawless final round to win the Women’s PGA Championship at Baltusrol Golf Club and claimed her first major title.
- A team of international scientists has discovered a deep-sea octopus nursery, just the third known to exist, off the coast of **Costa Rica**.
- **Egyptian** football club Al Ahly won record-extending 11th African Champions League title against defending champion Wydad Casablanca of Morocco in the second leg of the final that secured a 3-2 aggregate victory.
- The **Indian** men’s football team beat Lebanon 2-0 to win the Intercontinental Cup 2023 at the Kalinga Stadium in Bhubaneswar, winning their second Intercontinental Cup title.
- Professor Hiroaki Suga of the University of Tokyo, **Japan** received the prestigious 2023 Wolf Prize in Chemistry for his contributions to “pioneering discoveries that illuminate the functions and pathological dysfunctions of RNA and proteins and for creating strategies to harness the capabilities of these biopolymers in new ways to ameliorate human diseases.”
- **Kuwaiti** runner Yacoub Al-Youha emerged victorious at the 2023 Arab Athletic Championship, securing the gold medal in the 110-meter hurdles competition in Morocco.
- Red Bull’s Max Verstappen from the **Netherlands** completed another magical race by claiming a dominant victory at the 2023 Spanish F1 Grand Prix.
- A group of paleontologists from **New Zealand** has found the fossilized remains of the oldest known extinct little penguin, named Eudyptula. The two fossilized skulls were found by the team in the southern Taranaki region of New Zealand’s North Island, in the Tangahoe Formation.
- **Nigerian** Ijeoma Ibijoke Jummai McDougall was announced the winner of the prestigious Cheshire Woman Award for 2023 for her enormous contributions to the lives of the less privileged in Nigeria and the UK.
- **Qatar** and the **United Arab Emirates (UAE)** announced the reopening of their embassies after a six-year break in ties.
- **Serbian** Novak Djokovic won his 23rd Grand Slam title by beating Casper Ruud, 7-6, (7-1), 6-3, 7-5, in the French Open final.
- **Singapore** Airlines was named the World’s Best Airline at the 2023 World Airline Awards in Paris.
