## D+ News: October 2022

- Anton Zeilinger of **Austria**, John F. Clauser of the **USA** and Alain Aspect of **France** were jointly awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics 2022 for experiments with entangled photons, establishing the violation of Bell inequalities and pioneering quantum information science.
- The 2022 Peace Prize is awarded to human rights advocate Ales Bialiatski from **Belarus**, the **Russian** human rights organisation Memorial and the **Ukrainian** human rights organisation Center for Civil Liberties.
- **Bulgaria** and **Greece** started commercial operation of a 182-km gas pipeline which will help boost energy security for both the countries.
- **China** launched the space lab module Mengtian, taking the construction of the country's space station Tiangong into final stage.
- Morten Meldal of **Denmark** and Carolyn Bertozzi and K. Barry Sharpless of the **USA** won the Nobel Prize in Chemistry 2022 for the development of click chemistry and bioorthogonal chemistry.
- **French** writer Annie Ernaux won the Nobel Prize in Literature 2022 for the courage and clinical acuity with which she uncovers the roots, estrangements and collective restraints of personal memory.
- **Indian** Space Research Organisation (ISRO) successfully launched 36 satellites of OneWeb to their intended orbits, from the second launch pad at Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh.
- Svante Pääbo of **Sweden** won the Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine 2022 for his discoveries concerning the genomes of extinct hominins and human evolution.
- The Nobel Prize in Economic Sciences in Memory of Alfred Nobel 2022 was awarded jointly to Ben S. Bernanke, Douglas W. Diamond and Philip H. Dybvig from the **USA** for research on banks and financial crises.
- **China** sent a new satellite Shiyao-20 C into planned orbit from the Jiuquan Satellite Launch Center in northwest China.
- Real Madrid striker Karim Benzema won the men's Ballon d'Or, becoming the first **Frenchman** to claim the most prestigious individual prize in football since Zinedine Zidane almost a quarter of a century ago.
- **India** launched 5G telephony services as Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the much-awaited services at a telecom ministry event in New Delhi.
- Researchers at the University of Chicago in the **USA** have discovered a way to create a material that can be made like a plastic, but conducts electricity like a metal, according to a paper published in the journal Nature.
