D+ News: January 2023

- Jason Kubler and Rinky Hijikata of **Australia** won the Australian Open 2023 men's double tennis Grand Slam, after defeating Hugo Nys and Jan Zielinski 6-4 7-6(4) in the final.
- Associação Expedicionários da Saúde of **Brazil**, an NPO that provides specialised medical and surgical care for indigenous communities geographically isolated within the Amazon through its Mobile Hospital Complex, won the 2023 Zayed Sustainability Prize in the Health category.
- **Chinese** scientists at the Northwest A&F University have successfully cloned three "super cow" calves that, once fully grown, are capable of producing 50% more milk than the average American cow.
- Barbora Krejčíková and Katerina Siniaková of **Czech Republic** won the Australian Open 2023 women's doubles tennis champions, after posting a thrilling 6-4 6-3 victory over Shuko Aoyama and Ena Shibahara to clinch their seventh Grand Slam title together.
- Scientists have discovered a new species of dwarf boa in the **Ecuadoran** Amazon and named the 20 centimeters (7.8 inches) creature *Tropidophis cacuangoae*.
- Researchers at the University of London in **England** have found a range of organic matter in meteorite that crash landed in Gloucestershire that hold the secrets to the origin of life.
- **Kyrgyzstan's** energy ministry and the **United Arab Emirates (UAE)**'s clean energy company Masdar signed an agreement to develop clean energy projects with a capacity to generate up to 1 gigawatt.
- **Morocco's** football star Achraf Hakimi was awarded Best Arab Sportsman prize at the Joy Awards ceremony in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.
- **Nigeria** opened a billion-dollar, Chinese-built deep seaport in Lagos, which is expected to ease congestion at the country's ports and help it become an African hub for transshipment, handling cargoes in transit for other destinations.
- For the first time ever, the United States returned a looted antiquity to the **Palestine** - an Iron-age cosmetic spoon that is almost 3,000 years old.
- **Serbian** Novak Djokovic won the 2023 Australian Open Tennis Grand Slam with a 6-3 7-6(4) 7-6(5) scoreline to topple Stefanos Tsitsipas in the men's singles final at Rod Laver Arena.
- **Sweden's** state-owned mining company LKAB announced that it has identified more than 1 million tonnes of rare earth minerals in the northern area of Kiruna.
- **Swiss** Olympic champion ski racer Marco Odermatt took his fourth giant slalom win of the season in Adelboden.
- A team of scientists from Field Museum and the University of Chicago in the **USA** has discovered a near-17-pound monster space rock in icy Antarctica.
