D+ News: November 2016

- **Argentina** won its first-ever Davis Cup tennis title beating Croatia 3-2 in a thrilling Final in Zagreb.
- **China** successfully launched a meteorological satellite, Yunhai-1, carried by a Long March-2D rocket, the 240th mission for the Long March rocket family.
- Archaeologists have discovered an Egyptian city and graveyard dating back more than 7000 years in the ancient city of Abydos in southern **Egypt**.
- **English** scientists from the University of Bristol have grown a man-made diamond that, when placed in a radioactive field, is able to generate a small electrical current.
- Ghirmay Ghebreslassie of **Eritrea** won the 2016 New York City Marathon and became the race's youngest winner at the age of 19. Ghirmay also became the first Eritrean winner since the race began in 1970.
- **Estonia** ranked first at the Freedom on the Net 2016 index compiled by Freedom House.
- **French** astronaut Thomas Pesquet blasted into space aboard a Russian Soyuz rocket for a for six-month mission in the International Space Station.
- **German** driver Nico Rosberg won his first Formula 1 world title and became only the third German to win an F1 title.
- Bisa, a mobile application that allows mobile phone users to directly interact with medical practitioners without being physically present at the hospital, from **Ghana** received the prestigious Recognition of Excellence Certificates at the 2016 International Telecommunication Union (ITU) Telecom World Awards.
- **Israeli** researcher Dr. Gilad Evrony won the prestigious 2016 Eppendorf & Science Prize for Neurobiology for his work on developing technologies to sequence and analyse the genomes of single cells from the human brain.
- Mary Keitany of **Kenya** won her third-consecutive New York City Marathon title.
- The World Health Organization (WHO) officially certified **Kyrgyzstan** as a malaria-free country.
- **New Zealand** topped the Legatum Prosperity Index 2016, making it the best place in the world to live.
- **Norwegian** chess grandmaster Magnus Carlsen won the World Chess Championship for third time in a row after defeating Sergey Karjakin of Russia.
- **Filipino** singer and TV personality Sarah Geronimo was awarded the Best Asian Performer prize at the 2016 Classic Rock Awards in Japan.
- A **Russian** Soyuz rocket carrying an American and a French astronauts and a Russian cosmonaut was successfully launched to the International Space Station for a six-month mission.
- **Singaporean** students topped the global ranking in math and science, according to the International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS).
