D+ News: November 2023

- **Australia** beat host India by six wickets for sixth ICC Men's Cricket World Cup title in Ahmedabad after bowling out India for 240 runs.
- **China** launched the world's first ultra-high-speed next-generation Internet backbone with a bandwidth of 1,200G bits per second (1.2T), as revealed at the Tsinghua University in Beijing.
- Tamirat Tola of **Ethiopia** set a course record to win the New York City Marathon men's race, finishing in 2 hours, 4 minutes, 58 seconds, topping the 2:05:06 set by Geoffrey Mutai in 2011.
- **Finnish** researchers have discovered the composition of asteroid Phaethon which is five kilometers in diameter and has been puzzling researchers for a long time, as published in the journal Nature Astronomy.
- **German** scientists have detected atomic oxygen on the Venus's dayside — the side facing the Sun — for the first time, as published in the journal Nature Communications.
- **Ireland's** Katie Taylor beat Britain's Chantelle Cameron in a majority decision to become two-weight undisputed boxing champion.
- Paleontologists in **Mexico** have identified a new species of gigantic ancient sea monster, dubbed Yaguarasaurus Regiomontanus.
- The African Development Bank approved \$27 million grant for improved sanitation services in Chimoio, **Mozambique**, to give its inhabitants access to improved sanitation services.
- F1 driver Max Verstappen of the **Netherlands** beat Lando Norris for his 17th grand prix win of the year at the 2023 Sao Paulo Grand Prix.
- Sheynnis Palacios of **Nicaragua** was crowned the 2023 Miss Universe that took place in El Salvador's capital, San Salvador.
- **North Korea** successfully placed a spy satellite into orbit with its third launch attempt this year.
- The **Saudi** Central Bank and the People's Bank of **China** signed a local currency swap agreement, valid for three years and can be extended by mutual agreement, worth 50 billion yuan (\$6.93 billion) or 26 billion Saudi riyals.
- **Somalia** officially joined the East African Community (EAC) trade bloc as the eighth member as it seeks to expand free trade across the region. Somalia joined Burundi, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Kenya, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania and Uganda in the regional bloc.
- **Spanish** rider Alex Marquez won the Malaysian MotoGP sprint race at Sepang racing for Ducati satellite team Gresini Racing MotoGP.
- Researchers in **Switzerland** have printed a robot hand complete with bones, ligaments and tendons for the very first time, representing a major leap forward in 3D printing technology.
- **Tuvalu** signed historic climate refuge and security pact with Australia allowing residents of Tuvalu a chance to move to Australia to escape rising sea levels.
- **Uganda** qualified for the first time for the ICC Men's T20 Cricket World Cup 2024 after a nine-wicket victory over Rwanda.
