D+ News: October 2023

- **Afghanistan** produced their second stunning win of the ICC Men's Cricket World Cup 2023 to beat Pakistan for the first time ever in a men's ODI, winning by eight wickets in Chennai.
- **Argentine** football superstar Lionel Messi won the Ballon d'Or for a record eighth time after leading Argentina to the World Cup last year.
- **Australian** scientists have developed a new compact, lightweight, gel-free and waterproof electrocardiogram (ECG) sensor that offers more comfort and less skin irritation, compared to similar heart monitoring devices on the market.
- The 2023 Pan American Games, a continental multi-sport event in the Americas, was held in Santiago, **Chile** from October 20 to November 5, 2023.
- **Chinese** researchers from Tsinghua University have developed an all-analog photoelectronic chip that can process computer vision tasks with greater speed and energy efficiency than existing chips.
- Weightlifter Arley Lázaro Calderón Licourt won **Cuba's** first medal at the 2023 Pan American Games in Santiago, becoming champion of the 61-kilogram (kg) body weight category.
- **French** photographer Laurent Ballesta won the Grand Title at the 2023 Wildlife Photographer of the Year with an ethereal picture of a shimmering golden horseshoe crab.
- **German** and **Swiss** scientists have unlocked the mechanism of limb regrowth in axolotls, a type of salamander.
- Scientists Katalin Karikó from **Hungary** and Drew Weissman from the United States received the 2023 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine for discoveries enabling the development of mRNA COVID-19 vaccines.
- The **Indian** Space Research Organization (ISRO) successfully launched the first of a series of test flights in preparation for the ambitious human spaceflight mission – Gaganyaan – scheduled for 2025.
- Narges Mohammadi of **Iran** won the Nobel Peace Prize for 2023 for her fight against the oppression of women in Iran and her fight to promote human rights and freedom for all.
- The Japan Times, **Japan's** largest and oldest English-language daily newspaper, won the gold prize for breaking news coverage at the 2023 World Association of News Publishers Asian Media Awards.
- **Kenyan** long-distance runner Kelvin Kiptum set a new world record marathon time at 2:00:35 in the 2023 Chicago Marathon.
- **Morocco** was named as one of the co-hosts for the 2030 FIFA Men's Football World Cup along with Spain, Portugal, Uruguay, Argentina and Paraguay.
- Astronomers in the **Netherlands** have captured the world's first recording of two ice giant exoplanets collision and its subsequent aftermath and the observations were detailed in the journal Nature.
